**ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE**

Pursuant to ORS 540.580, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8135, a petition submitted by

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

Therefore, these changes to existing district water rights may be made subject to the following conditions:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1999.
2. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.
3. Proof, to the satisfaction of the Director, that the changes approved by this order have been completed must be submitted by STANFIELD IRRIGATION DISTRICT on or before October 1, 2000.


Furthermore,

4. Except as modified herein, all other conditions and restrictions of Certificate 74662 AND Permit 7400 remain in effect.
5. When the Director determines that it is necessary, or to facilitate records keeping, new certificates will be issued to confirm all completed changes for which satisfactory proof has been made and to confirm that portion of the right not modified by this or any other order.

This order supersedes the order recorded at Volume 53, Pages 451 and 452 approving T-8135 which failed to include the transfer from Lambert to Snow.
