**Authority**

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time for the completion of changes authorized under water right transfers.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On October 21, 2013, the Department received an application for extension of time for water right Transfer Application T-10887 from Darren Shelburne.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10887 in the name of Darren Shelburne on March 26, 2010. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 80, at Pages 520 - 522. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2011.
3. The beneficial use of 0.33 cubic foot per second of water on 26.5 acres has been completed. However, the installation of a totalizing flow meter on the well (YAMH 6507) has not occurred.
4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to install a totalizing flow meter on the well (YAMH 6507).
5. The landowner has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2015.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**Conclusions of Law**

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10887 and the requested time is reasonable.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by Transfer Application T-10887 shall be extended to October 1, 2015.
