Authority

ORS 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On May 27, 2008, Stepping Stones Land LLC filed an application to change the point of appropriation under Permit G-11923. The Department assigned the application number T-10638.
- The permit to be amended is as follows:

Permit:

G-11923, in the name of Stepping Stones Land LLC

Use:

Irrigation of 14.1 acres

Priority Date: January 22, 1993

Quantity:

0.18 cubic foot per second (cfs)

Rate/Duty:

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation

season of each year.

Source:

A well, in the Gribble Creek Basin.

Date of Complete Application of Water:

October 1, 2010

- 5. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on June 3, 2008, and in the Canby Herald newspaper on September 10, 17, and 24, 2008, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notices.
- 6. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 7. The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 8. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-10638 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The change and subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 2. Prior to water use from the proposed points of appropriation, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-11923 remain the same.
- 5. Permit G-11923, in the name of Stepping Stones Land LLC, is amended as described herein.
