On January 11, 1978, Mabel A. Patterson submitted an affidavit that she is the owner and David G. Thomas submitted an affidavit that he is the contract purchaser of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Jackson County entered May 19, 1964, tabulated at page 386, Volume 13, in the name of George A. Woodcock, and a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 32798, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Arthur W. Patterson, successor in interest to George A. Woodcock, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from Evans Creek, with a date of priority of 1902, for domestic and stock use in NE¼ NE¼ of Section 9, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 32798, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
