On September 14, 1984, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Owyhee Irrigation District for approval of a change in place of use of water from Owyhee River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 24707, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second from Owyhee River, for irrigation of 1.86 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 47 East, WM; 1.96 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 46 East, WM; and 5.00 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 47 East, WM, with dates of priority of February 14, 1916 and August 19, 1924.

The applicant herein proposes to transfer the right therefrom to a certain 4.0 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 22, Township 19 South, Range 46 East, WM and 4.82 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 46 East, WM. The applicant further proposes to cancel supplemental irrigation rights from Snake River under Certificates 3297, 24704 and 51346 for said lands. The change in place of use is reported to be completed.

Supplemental irrigation rights as described by Certificate 44030 from Owyhee Reservoir will be transferred with said primary rights.

Frank W. Elfering, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that aforesaid portions of Certificates 3297, 24704 and 51346 for supplemental irrigation of the lands in aforesaid Sections 28, 22 and 29 are canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change of water right shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 24707.
