POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER)	

On December 17, 1986, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Oregon State Parks Division for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Roque River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 32435, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Oregon State Highway Commission, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second from Rogue River, for public park use in Tou Velle State Park, within SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, both as projected within T. Thompson DLC 41; Lot 3 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), Lot 10 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4), and NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within T. Thompson DLC 41, Section 13, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, WM, with a date of priority of March 31, 1954.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 500 feet North and 675 feet West from the Center of Section 13, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 40 feet North and 1560 feet West from the Center of Section 13, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, WM.

Bruce R. Sund, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the right to divert water from the point described in Certificate 32435 is hereby canceled, and water shall be used from the new diversion point on or before October 1, 1988.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 32435, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
