ORDER APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6743 submitted by

ALBERT L. OSMIN
ROUTE ONE, BOX 336
HEPPNER, OREGON 97836

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for MORROW County as evidenced by Certificate 136. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1895.

The right allows the use of WILLOW CREEK, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 67 ACRES (DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON). The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.12 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: EVANS DITCHES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 26.0 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 10.0 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 9.0 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 4.0 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 18.0 ACRES

SECTION 7

TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes an additional point of diversion to:


SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 2 S, R 26 E, W.M.; 2350 FEET SOUTH AND 3040 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 7.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

Certificate 136 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
