ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 8464 submitted by

ROBERT SIMPSON P.O. BOX 535 CHRISTMAS VALLEY, OREGON 97641.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 52617, was perfected under Permit G-8841 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 13, 1980. The right allows the use of a WELL, in the FORT ROCK BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 19.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW½ NW½, SECTION15, T 25 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 820 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE W½ CORNER, SECTION 15, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

this is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

SECTION 15

TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be reduced.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

SW¼ SW¼ 19.0 ACRES SECTION 5 TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

The applicant further proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 5, T 27 S, R 18 E, W.M.; 990 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 5.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 2002.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.

- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificate 52617 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
