ORDER CANCELING A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT

An affidavit was received from John J., Eileen, Henry F., and Judith Bishop, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 64111, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.18 cubic foot per second from a Well, a tributary of Malheur River Basin. The date of priority is January 19, 1981. The abandoned water right is for supplemental irrigation of 14.8 acres.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.6 ACRES
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 11.2 ACRES
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

The water right described herein is canceled. Certificate 64111 is canceled and a new certificate will be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
