

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of H. H. Van Valkenburg and it appearing that under Certificate No. 5069 issued under Permit No. 4355, a right to water from the Klamath River was allowed for 140 acres in Sections 22, 25 and 27, Township 39 South, Range 8 East, W.M. under priority of December 26, 1919; that the water under said right has heretofore been diverted from the Klamath River at a point near the SE corner of Section 27; that the applicant now proposed to change the point of diversion of said water by diverting same from the Klamath River near the center of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 39 South, Range 8 East, W.M. and it appearing that a notice, as provided by Section 5764, Oregon Laws, was duly published and a date set for hearing at which time no appearance was made nor objections filed and it further appearing that such change in point of diversion will be of advantage to the applicant and that no other right will be injured by such change;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in point of diversion be and the same is hereby approved.
