Affidavits were received from Raymond and Joann Illingsworth, Carlton and Eldiva Loenning, and Dennis and Kathleen Spence, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The storage portion of the water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by certificate 4151, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of water stored in KILLAMACUE RESERVOIR, a tributary of POWDER RIVER. The date of priority is 1879.

The abandoned water right is for the purpose of IRRIGATING 200.0 ACRES. A description of the place of use under the abandoned right and to which it is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 ACRES SE 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 ACRES NE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 ACRES NW 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 ACRES SW 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 ACRES SECTION 26 TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is cancelled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate 4151 is cancelled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
