On August 26, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Kenneth Ronald Pinkerton for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Santiam River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 45171, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Rosie Brandel, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.057 cubic foot per second from South Santiam River for irrigation of 5.0 acres in NW I/4 NE I/4, as projected within Ambler DLC 57, Section 29, Township 12 South, Range I West, WM, with a date of priority of February 17, 1949.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 12 South, Range 1 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom to a point located 830 feet North and 2400 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Ambler DLC 57, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 12 South, Range I West, WM. The change in point of diversion is reported to be completed.

L. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.057 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 45171, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
