PLACE OF USE OF WATER )

On September 12, 1988, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Marguerite E. Davis for approval of a change in place of use of water from Tumalo Creek and the Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The right established by performance under the terms of Water Right Transfer 4222, in the name of C. P. Gungura, includes the use of water from Tumalo Creek, for irrigation of 2.5 acres in SW1/4 SE1/4, Section 24, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM, with a date of priority of September, 1900. These lands also have supplemental rights evidenced by Certificate 31412, Volume 23, to the use of water from the Deschutes River and Crescent Lake Reservoir with a date of priority of 1905. These lands are irrigated by means of the Columbia Southern Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands described above, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to a certain 2.5 acres in NE1/4 NE1/4 (Tax lot 202), Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, WM.(Littrell)

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Tumalo Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting on June 9, 1987.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the subject water right is hereby severed from the place of use described in Transfer 4222, and shall be beneficially used as authorized in this order on or before October 1, 1990.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change of water right shall be considered perfected, and at a later date, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Tumalo Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 31410.
