ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6560 submitted by

ART AND BETTY BRUNI 34081 LEATHERS LANE COTTAGE GROVE OREGON 97424.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 34567, was perfected under Permit 29875 with a date of priority of JULY 21, 1964. The right allows the use of ROW RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION 1.1 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW\(\frac{1}{2}\) NE\(\frac{1}{4}\), as projected within OGLEBY DLC 66, SECTION 36, T 20 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2190 FEET NORTH AND 1230 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHERLY NE CORNER OF MOSEBY DLC 65, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE NW 1.1 ACRES

SECTION 36

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

NE NW, SECTION 36, T 20 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2115 FEET NORTH AND 1765 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHERLY NW CORNER OF MOSEBY DLC 65.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 34567 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
