ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6554 submitted by

TOM AND NANCY VANASCHE 37731 NE BOND ROAD ALBANY, OREGON 97321.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 62107, was perfected under Permit 47557 with a date of priority of MARCH 29, 1983. The right allows the use of SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER, a tributary of SANTIAM RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 38.9 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.49 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 7 (NW\(\) NE\(\) , SECTION 30, T 10 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1060 FEET NORTH AND 1380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 42, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

LOT 7 (NW¼ NE⅓) 17.3 ACRES LOT 10 (SW¾ NE⅓) 20.0 ACRES LOT 6 (NE⅓ NW⅓) 0.2 ACRE LOT 11 (SE⅓ NW⅓) 1.4 ACRES SECTION 30

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to:

LOT 11 (SE% NW%), SECTION 30, T 10 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 520 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF DLC 42.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1993.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificate 62107 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
