FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Keith Truax, Lessor, and the Oregon Water Trust, lessee, submitted a Short-Term Lease Application on April 26, 2004. The Instream Lease Application was assigned lease agreement number L-551. The Department issued an order approving the Short-Term Lease on June 2, 2004. The order was filed at Special Order Volume 60, Page 185.
- 2. After issuance of the Final Order, the Department identified that the authorized place of use for the right to be leased instream was incorrectly described in the final order. The authorized place of use for the right to be lease leased instream, should be described as:
