On August 30, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Terry R. Townley for approval of a change in place of use of water from Malheur River and Warmsprings Reservoir, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 15719, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation, describes a right which includes the use of water from Malheur River and Warmsprings Reservoir for irrigation of 13.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 3.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 44 East, WM, with dates of priority of May 10, 1926 and January 11, 1927.

These lands have a supplemental right from North Fork Malheur River and Agency Valley Reservoir under Certificate 15808.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to a certain 16.0 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 13, Township 18 South, Range 43 East, WM.

Frank W. Elfering, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1985.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change in place of use shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to Vale-Oregon Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District and superseding Certificate 15719.
