### Authority

## **Findings of Fact**

1. On March 16, 2009, Hickey Ranches and H7H Cattle Feeders filed an application to renew instream lease L-469, involving a portion of Certificates 8597 and 42409. The Department assigned the application number IL-469.

2. The portion of the first right to be leased is as follows:

- 5. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0076(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(1). No comments were received.
- 6. Certificates 8579 and 42409 do not specify an irrigation season. Nor is one specified by Basin Program or decree. However, an irrigation season of March 1 through October 31 may be applied, for purposes of this lease, consistent with OAR 690-250.
- 7. The instream use is as follows:

Whiskey Creek, tributary to Sprague River

Instream Reach: From POD (as described in Finding of Fact #3) to the mouth of Whiskey Creek

8. Other conditions to prevent injury and enlargement are:

The source of water for Certificate 8579, Whiskey Creek, fluctuates seasonally. Supplemental Certificate 42409 is being protected instream as primary to make up deficiencies in the primary source.

- 9. If approved, this instream lease is not reasonably expected to significantly affect land use as prescribed by ORS 197.180, OAR Chapter 660, Divisions 30 and 31, and OAR Chapter 690, Division 5.
- 10. Based upon review of the application, comments received, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other available information, the Department finds that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the lease may be modified or revoked under OAR 690-077-0077 if the Department later finds that the lease is causing injury to any existing water right or enlargement of the original right.
- 11. If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-077-0075 a new injury review shall be required. Transfers will be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 and Division 077. Approval of this lease does not establish a precedent for approval of future leases or transfers.

13. The Lessor has requested the option of terminating the lease early with written notice to the Department.

# **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The Department concludes that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077. The lease conforms to the applicable provisions of OAR 690-077-0015.

#### ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. That the Lease as described herein is APPROVED.
- 2. The former place of use will no longer receive water as part of these rights, any supplemental rights, or any other layered water rights for irrigation use, including ground water registrations during the term of the lease.
- 3. The lease will terminate on October 31, 2013. For multiyear leases, the lessor *shall* have the option of terminating the lease each year with written notice to the Department. The lease may be terminated at any time during the calendar year. However, if the termination request is received less than 30-days prior to the period of allowed instream use (May 1) or after the period of allowed use has begun for the water right(s) being leased, water shall not be used under the right(s) leased until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur.
