ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4310

On October 18, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert K. Beesley for approval of a change in place of use from Well No. 9, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 46148, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Deschutes Valley Farms, Inc., describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 1.15 cubic feet per second from Well No. 9 for primary irrigation of 1.1 acres in the SW4 SW4 of Section 17 and 2.2 acres in the SE4 SE4 of Section 18; and supplemental irrigation of 19.1 acres in the NE4 SW4, 12.2 acres in the NW4 SW4, 22.1 acres in the SW4 SW4, 31.8 acres in the SE4 SW4, 2.1 acres in the SW4 SE4, and 1.5 acres in the NW4 SE4 of Section 17, all in Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W. M., with a date of priority of April 15, 1969.

The point of appropriation for the said right is located 20 feet South and 980 feet East from the Northwest Corner of SW4 NW4, Section 17, being within the SW4 NW4 of Section 17, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to sever the rights therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof: for primary irrigation: 3.3 acres in the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 18; for supplemental irrigation: 29.0 acres in the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 40.0 acres in the SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ and 19.8 acres in the NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 46148, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
