ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. G-57

On August 10, 1964, Georgia-Pacific Corporation of Portland, Oregon, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Fork Coquille River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to J. R. Wiley and Herbert S. Berry and recorded at page 14239, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of the waters of South Fork Coquille River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 16.6 acres in Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), 9.6 acres in Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and 7.14 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 21, 1939. These lands are irrigated by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said pumping plant being located 720 feet north and 1825 feet west from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of Section 28, and being within Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 28, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate said lands by means of a pumping plant to be located 1105 feet north and 594 feet west from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of Section 28, and being within Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), said Section 28, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. C. O. Bartels, Watermaster of District No. 15, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from South Fork Coquille River, to-wit:

From a point located 720 feet north and 1825 feet west from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of Section 28, and being within Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$), Section 28, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 1105 feet north and 594 feet west from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ corner of Section 28, and being within Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$), said Section 28, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 16.6 acres in Lot 8 (SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$), 9.6 acres in Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$) and 7.14 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 28, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 21, 1939, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1965, or within such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


That the pumping plant and related works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the plans of the weir or other suitable device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that cancelation of certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. R. Wiley and Herbert S. Berry and recorded at page 14239, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, shall be provided for in the Order on a separate pending water right transfer application for a change in point of diversion affecting other lands covered by this certificate, and upon completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Georgia-Pacific Corporation confirming said change in point of diversion.
