An affidavit was received from GREGORY J. WIECK, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 9311, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of ONE-EIGHTIETH cubic foot per second per acre from WALLOWA LAKE RESERVOIR (Eagle Cap Reservoir), a tributary of WALLOWA RIVER. The date of priority is January 9, 1915. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 20.0 ACRES.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 20.0 ACRES SECTION 16 TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled.
