Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration before the State Engineer on the application of Amanda C. Moore by her attorney, A. B. Mount and it appearing that by the Decree of the Circuit Court for Baker County dated March 18, 1918, Charles Harvill was awarded a right for the irrigation of 1.5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 7.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 16.5 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, 12 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 46 East, W.M. and that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1897 for 3.5 acres through the Newt Young Ditch; 1901 for 12 acres and 1909 for 33 acres through the Howell Ditch and which was thereafter conveyed to said Amanda C. Moore;


That it is now proposed to divert the water from Eagle Creek into the Newt Young Ditch to the lands above described for irrigation purposes without loss of priority. That the reasons for making said change is for the purpose of conserving the water by giving a nearer route and affording more substantial ditch base and the elimination of flumes at less upkeep. That arrangements have been made with both the Howell Ditch Company and the owners of the Newt Young Ditch for making this change.

That a notice of filing such application has been given by the State Engineer by publication in the Democrat Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in Baker County for three suc-

cessive and consecutive weeks and that no objections to such application have been filed and it appearing that the proposed change may be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW THEREFORE it is hereby ORDERED that the said change be and the same is hereby approved without loss of priority for the rights as heretofore established.
