An affidavit was received from DEAN G. and MARY DEMENT SMITH, the owners of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 55739, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 2.5 ACRE FEET PER ACRE from SNOW AND THREE CREEKS, tributaries of SQUAW CREEK. The date of priority is 1897. The abandoned water right is for IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

MORE EXPLICITLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Lot 13, Block 5, Ponderosda Cascade

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 55739 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
