ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN USE, PLACE OF USE
AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7496 submitted by

HANSELL BROTHERS INCORPORATED
ROUTE 1 BOX 1710
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 74107, was perfected under Permit G-3822 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 15, 1968. The right allows the use of WELL 2, in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL HOG RAISING. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.40 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 27, T 4 N, R 27 E, WM; 1420 FEET NORTH AND 490 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 27, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼
NE¼ SE¼
NW¼ SE¼
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the USE from supplemental hog raising to SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 32.0 ACRES.

The applicant proposes to change the place of use to:

SW¼ SW¼ 32.0 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 27 EAST, W.M.

The applicant also proposes to change the point of appropriation to:

SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 26, T 4 N, R 27 E, WM; WELL 8 - 1160 FEET NORTH AND 370 FEET EAST FROM THE W¼ CORNER, SECTION 26.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1998.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
3. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
5. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
6. The former use and place of use shall no longer be receive water as part of this water right.

Certificate 74107 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
