## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. A Short-Term Lease Application, which proposed to lease all or a portion of certificate(s) 32329 for instream purposes was submitted to the Department by:

- 2. The instream lease application included the required fees. The Department assigned this lease agreement number L-489.
- 3. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0077(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(6). No comments were received.
- 4. The instream flow will be allocated on a daily average basis up to the described rate of 0.54 cfs from April 1 (not before execution of the lease) through September 30.
- 5. Based upon review of the application, comments received, and information provided by the Department's Watermaster, the Department finds that the lease, as modified, will not result in injury or enlargement.
- 6. The lease will terminate on September 30, 2004.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department concludes that the lease, as modified above, will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077.

## ORDER

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the Short-Term Lease as described in application L-489 as modified is APPROVED.
