Permit No. 8014 was issued to Aubrey N. Davis, J. O. Mark and Glenn D. Allen on July 14, 1927 authorizing the diversion of 0.1 cubic foot per second of water from a spring tributary of O'Dell Creek for domestic purposes.

Application has now been made for an amendment to this permit to increase the quantity of water to 0.25 second foot and plans submitted by the applicant show a proposal to construct a pipe line of sufficient size to carry that quantity of water which is to be used for domestic purposes in the town of O'Dell, Oregon, and

It appearing that the limitation of 0.1 second foot as fixed in the permit was fixed through error and that the applicants are entitled to the full quantity of water for which application was originally made.

It is therefore ORDERED that the quantity of water to be appropriated under the permit be increased to 0.25 second foot and that the original application and permit be recalled to this office for amendment in accordance with this order and that a similar amendment be made upon the recorded copy of such application and permit as the same appears of record in the office of the State Engineer.
