**ORDER APPROVING USE AND  
DISPOSITION OF A PORTION  
APPLICANT'S PORTION OF  
CONSERVED WATER**

**Applicable Law**

ORS 537.455 to 537.500 authorize and establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request for an allocation of conserved water. OAR Chapter 690, Division 18, implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating conserved water applications and for implementing the use of the conserved water.

Pursuant to ORS 537.470(3), the Department determined the allocation of conserved water under Conserved Water Application CW-62. Any person or agency allocated conserved water under ORS 537.470 may reserve the water instream for future out-of-stream use or otherwise use or dispose of the conserved water. Any person or agency to whom conserved water is allocated shall notify the Commission of any change in the type of use, place of use, or point of diversion.

The Director shall approve a change in the type of use, place of use, or point of diversion for conserved water, if: 1) the proposed new use is within the area described under OAR 690-018-0050(4)(h); 2) the proposed change would not constitute an expansion of the right; and 3) the approval is consistent with OAR 690-005-0045 (Standards for Goal Compliance and Compatibility with Acknowledged Comprehensive Plans).

**Findings of Fact**

1. On April 2, 2013, the Department issued a Final Order Correcting and Finalizing the First Portion of Allocation of Conserved Water CW-62 (Final Order), recorded at Special Order Volume 89, Pages 145 - 155.
2. The Final Order identified the Applicant's portion of conserved water as follows:

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- On February 26, 2015, prior to the start of the irrigation season, the Applicant submitted notification of the intent to use its portion of conserved water that was temporarily reserved instream for future out-of-stream use.

6. On April 6, 2015, the Applicant submitted a 60-Day Notice of Use or Disposition for a portion of the Applicant's Portion of Conserved Water for CW-62 along with the required documentation.
7. On April 20, 2015, the Department issued an Order Approving Use and Disposition of a Portion of Applicant's portion of Conserved Water, recorded at Special Order Volume 95, Page 588. The Order approved the use of 5.34 cfs and 750 acre feet having the remainder managed instream for future out-of-stream use.

10. The irrigators shall have sufficient totalizing measuring devices installed for reporting and monitoring the water use from CW-62. The Reports must be submitted annually by the end of each Calendar year to the Watermaster. The Department reserves the option to request additional data, measuring devices and more frequent reporting if necessary.
11. The end result of this Notice of Use and Disposition form is the full quantity of the Applicant's Portion of Conserved Water is currently being utilized on lands for irrigation purposes.

**Conclusions of Law**

1. The proposed use is within the area described under OAR 690-018-0050(4)(h).
2. The proposed use would not constitute an expansion of the right.
3. The proposed use is consistent with OAR 690-005-0045(Standards for Goal Compliance and Compatibility with Acknowledged Comprehensive Plans).

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The use of water as described in Finding of Fact #9 is approved.
2. All other provisions of the Order Approving Use and Disposition of a Portion of the Applicant's Portion of Conserved Water dated April 20, 2015, recorded at Special Order Volume 95, Page 588, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. The use of water as identified in Finding of Fact #9 is subject to the provisions of OAR 690-0018-0090(6) and ORS 540.610 to 540.660.
