BEFORE THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR OF OREGON

On November 30, 1978, Phillip and Barbara Goulet submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 34300, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Creighton B. Jones, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.9 cubic foot per second of water from Deep Lake, with a date of priority of April 8, 1953, for supplemental irrigation of 4.8 acres in the SW_4^1 SW_4^1 of Section 1; 9.2 acres in the NE_4^1 SE_4^1 , 9.0 acres in the NW_4^1 SE_4^1 , 23.0 acres in the SW_4^1 SE_4^1 , 25.2 acres in the SE_4^1 of Section 2; and 2.7 acres in the NE_4^1 NE_4^1 of Section 11, all as projected within Beers D.L.C. No. 38 in Township 6 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 34300, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
