ORDER

On October 1, 1982, Elso DeJong submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is described by the certificate recorded at page 46053, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of M. and Verna Sewald, and is for the use of not to exceed 1.77 cubic feet per second of water from one well, with a date of priority of February 26, 1951, for irrigation of:

5.3 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
26.0 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
7.2 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4  
4.7 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 16

38.2 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4  
34.5 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4  
25.3 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
Section 21



ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, described by the certificate recorded at page 46053, Volume 38, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled.
