**Authority**

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On April 30, 2014, the Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-11693. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 92, Pages 318-324.
2. The order contained a scrivener error in the date the application was received the date should have been identified as **November 22, 2013**.
3. The order also contained a scrivener's error in the description of the authorized point of diversion for Certificate 76122. The error is identified in **bold** in the table below:

4. The **corrected**, authorized point of diversion are listed in the table below:

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The order approving Transfer Application T-11693, recorded at Special Order Volume 92, Pages 318-324 is amended to correctly describe the date the application was received and the authorized point of diversion for Certificate 76122 as listed in Finding of Facts #2 and #3.
2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
