FINDINGS OF FACT


Permits numbered R-1827 and 24019, issued on March 20, 1956 in approval of applications numbered R-30500 and 30501 in the name of Vivian M. Reinhardt, granted the right to construct Reinhardt Reservoir and store therein 2.5 acre feet of water from Panther Creek and seepage for irrigation purposes and to appropriate not to exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second of water from Panther Creek, seepage, and storage in Reinhardt Reservoir for the irrigation of 30 acres of land within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Due to a clerical error in the records of the State Engineer the Reservoir Permit No. R-1827 was included in the permit cancellation order of the State Engineer entered on August 9, 1960 at Volume 10, Page 485, Special Order Record of the State Engineer, when in fact the permit was in good standing on the records of the State Engineer on the date the cancellation order was entered.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the permit cancellation order of the State Engineer entered on August 9, 1960 at Volume 10, Page 485, Special Order Record of the State Engineer, referring to permit No. R-1827 shall be and the same hereby is of no force or effect.
