ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. 2723

On October 11, 1972, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Roy A. and Lois B. Wisbrock for approval of a change in place of use from Choke Cherry Gulch and springs, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 38653, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Glenn A. and Verna Prottsman, describes a right which includes the use of water from Choke Cherry Gulch and springs for irrigation of a certain 2.13 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Turner D.L.C. No. 39, of Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1855.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Woodcock Ditch, from a point located 765 feet North and 950 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the place of use therefrom, without loss of priority, and to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 2.13 acres in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.


NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore

issued to Glenn A. and Verna Prottzman and recorded at page 38653, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
