## ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 8739 submitted by

OLIVER AND CHRISTIE WILDE 44142 BANTA ROAD BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814.

The FIRST right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Permit 50622 with a date of priority of JUNE 1, 1987. The right allows the use of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 76.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.9 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NW% SE%, SECTION 28, T 7 S, R 41 E, W.M.; BASCHE DITCH - 1880 FEET NORTH AND 400 FEET EAST FROM THE S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 28, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described

The SECOND right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 75979, was perfected under Permit 36473 with a date of priority of AUGUST 24, 1971. The right allows the use of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 76.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.33 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW% SE%, SECTION 17, T 8 S, R 42 E, W.M.; 650 FEET NORTH AND 2540 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 17, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further

limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

- 2. The former places of use shall **not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2001 irrigation season.
- 3. The use shall revert to the authorized places of use at the end of the 2001 irrigation season.
- 4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 5. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
