Transfer application No. G-77, in the name of William Gieber, proposed a change in point of diversion of water from Abiqua Creek under a certain water right with a priority date of June 24, 1940, to irrigate a certain 2.3 acres in NW4 NW4 of Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M., from a point of diversion located South 51° 30' East, 1647 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NW4 NW4 of Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The order of the State Engineer, predecessor of the Water Resources Director, entered August 27, 1969, approving transfer application No. G-77, provided: "that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1970."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of completion of change in point of diversion, therefore, no new certificate will be issued for the subject water right, pursuant to said order.
