

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION)
OF MARY E. SWEENEY FOR PERMISSION)
TO CHANGE THE POINT OF DIVERSION)

O R D E R.

Now at this time this matter coming on for the consideration of the State Engineer upon the petition of Mary E. Sweeney, and it appearing that on May 27th, 1914, first water right certificate No. 444 was issued to M. N. Loughridge, et al, under permit No. E 40, covering a right for the appropriation of 2.63 second feet of the waters of Applegate River under priority of March 2nd, 1910, for the irrigation of 210 acres of land in Sections 19, 20, 21, and 28, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, W. M; that said lands were to be irrigated through the Swinden Ditch described in said permit as diverting water from said stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 35, of said Township and Range; that it is now proposed to divert water in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28 of said Township and Range for the irrigation of a part of said lands, being 23 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21; that an investigation of the proposed change has been made by M. L. Opdycke, water master for said district, who has submitted his report and recommendations thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, it appearing that the change in the location of the point of diversion of water for the irrigation of the lands last described would not interfere with other rights from said stream, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in the location of the point of diversion be and the same is hereby approved.
