ORS 536.750 establishes the process in which the holder of both a primary surface water right and a supplemental ground water right may substitute the use of the supplemental water right for the primary water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 019 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

Findings of Fact

- 1. Stephen and Laidee Ann Wolfe filed an application to temporarily substitute the use of a supplemental ground water right (Permit G-15796) for primary surface water rights (T-5773, T-5774 and T-5794) for a period of one year or the term of the Governor's declared drought, whichever is shorter. The Department assigned the application number T-9915.
- 2. The first right to be transferred is as follows:

Permit: G-15796 in the name of Stephen and Laidee Ann Wolfe

Use: Supplemental Irrigation of 60.58 acres

Priority Date: April 8, 2004

Quantity: 0.76 cubic foot per second (cfs)

Rate/Duty: 1/80 cfs per acre, not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre

Source: Well 1 in the Umatilla River Basin

- 6. Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS

540.523(6) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.

Conclusions of Law

The temporary substitution proposed in application T-9915 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 536.750 and OAR 690-019-0059.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The temporary substitution proposed in application T-9915 is approved.
- 2. The proposed use shall revert to the authorized use at the end of the 2005 irrigation season or the end of the Governor's declared drought, whichever occurs first.
- 3. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
- 4. Issuance of this temporary drought transfer order may not protect the person receiving the transfer from liability for improper use of the water under the transfer.
- 5. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Permit G-15796, T-5773, T-5774 and T-5794 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
- 6. The temporary use of water authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Permit G-15796, T-5773, T-5774 and T-5794.
- 7. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. **Prior** to diverting of water at the new point of diversion, the water user **shall** install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 9. The use of the remaining water right described by Permit G-15796, T-5773, T-5774 and T-5794 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Permit G-15796, T-5773, T-5774 and T-5794.
