
Findings of Fact

1. The Department issued an order approving T-9375 on June 14, 2004. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 60, Pages 320-323. No material aspect of the transaction represented by T-9375, other than accurate rights tracking, is affected by this order.
2. The order and remaining right certificate incorrectly identified Certificate 75660 as being superseded by Certificate 80662, when in fact Certificate 75660 was superseded by Certificate 80712.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The order approving T-9375 as recorded in Special Order Volume 60, Pages 320-323, is corrected as described in Findings of Fact #2 above.
2. Certificate 81466 shall be issued to supersede Certificate 80662, thus indicating the correct provenance of rights under Certificate 75660 NOT affected by T-9375.
3. Certificate 80662 is cancelled.
4. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
