On June 4, 1980, Janyce A. Traughber submitted an affidavit that she is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that she has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was allowed by Decree of Circuit Court for Grant County, entered November 16, 1956, in the Matter of Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of John Day River, tabulated at page 618, Volume 10, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in the name of Bradford C. Trowbridge, and is described by the certificate recorded at page 42919, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Bradford C. Trowbridge, and is for the use of not to exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre of water from John Day River, with a date of priority of 1875, for irrigation of a certain 0.3 acre in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, described by the certificate recorded at page 42919, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
