**Authority**

**Findings of Fact**

1. On October 21, 2016, the Department issued a Final Order and Superseding Permit G-17641 for an additional point of appropriation proposed under Permit Amendment T-12319 and approved by Special Order Volume 103, Page 329.
2. The Superseding Permit contained a scrivener's error describing one of the 1/4-1/4 (Q-Q) locations in the place of use table and is show below in bold:

40S	9 E	WM	28	<b>NE SW</b>	10	36.23

3. The correct 1/4- 1/4 (Q-Q) is below in bold:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	GLot	Acres
40S	9 E	WM	28	<b>NE SE</b>	10	36.23


**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. Permit G-17708 in the name of Lee R. Sukraw, is issued to replace Permit G-17641, and incorporates the correction approved by this order. Permit G-17641, in the name Lee R. Sukraw, is no longer of any force or effect.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

2. All other terms and conditions of Special Order Volume 103, Page 329 remain the same.
