ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 9062 submitted by

JOYCE E. COATS
63285 SKYLINE RANCH
BEND, OREGON 97701.

The FIRST right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 72197. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 282 and Volume 16, at Pages 146 and 396. The date of priority is OCTOBER 31, 1900.

The right allows the use of the DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 85.2 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.047 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the Crook County Improvement District #1 weir.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 29, T 17 S, R 12 E, W.M.; NORTH 35°
45' WEST 1056.8 FEET FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion not to exceed the quantity determined by the duty of water as set by decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, dated March 24, 1933, being:

April 1 to May 1 & Oct. 1 to Nov. 1	1 cfs to 137.0 acres
May 1 to May 15 & Sept. 15 to Oct. 1	1 cfs to 109.0 acres
May 15 to Sept. 15	1 cfs to 86.6 acres

as measured at the Lone Pine Weir, not to exceed 4.2 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to TEMPORARILY change the place of use to:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 18.5 ACRES

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 24.5 ACRES

LOT 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) 0.8 ACRE

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 13.9 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. These changes are temporary. These changes shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
2. The former place of use shall **not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2002 irrigation season.


The portions of the water rights evidenced by T-6741 (Vol. 56, Pg. 32), Certificate 76714 (Permit S-23256) and Certificate 44619 (Permit S-28702) appurtenant to the former place of use shall **not** be used during the 2002 irrigation season.

3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2002 irrigation season.
4. The portions of the water right evidenced by Certificate 76714 (Permit S-23256) and Permit G-12367 appurtenant to the proposed place of use shall **not** be used during the 2002 irrigation season.

5. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
6. **Prior** to using water in the proposed location, the water user **shall** install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
7. The **entire pivot** (pivot #4) located within Section 33, T 13 S, R 14 E, W.M. and Section 4, T 14 S, R 14 E, W.M. **shall** remain **inactive** during the entire 2002 irrigation season.
8. The use of the remaining water right described by Certificate 72197 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificate 72197.
