ORDER REVOKING TEMPORARY TRANSFER 9026

Temporary Transfer 9026, in the name of Bryan Schurter, was approved April 11, 2002. The water right was to revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2005 irrigation season.

Bryan Schurter, has requested, in writing, that Temporary Transfer 9026 be withdrawn in conjunction with the approval of current temporary transfer applications 9507 and 9508. While an approved temporary transfer application may not be withdrawn, the approved temporary transfer may be revoked. To comply with the water right holder's request, Temporary Transfer 9026 should be revoked.

Temporary Transfer 9026 is REVOKED, and of no further force of effect. The water right shall immediately revert to its authorized place of use.
