**Findings of Fact**

1. On October 1, 2007, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-9574 from Linda J. Isola.
2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-9574 in the name of Linda J. Isola, on September 13, 2005. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 67, at Page 130. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2006.
3. The applicant has installed a 3HP centrifugal pump. Also, the mainline, laterals and sprinklers for the irrigation of the landscape have been installed over the 2.0 acres of land. The fish screen has also been installed and approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.
4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording.
5. The landowner has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2008.

**Conclusions of Law**


Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-9574.

<p>This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.</p>

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-9574 shall be extended to October 1, 2008.
