OAR 690-380-6010(6) provides that a point of diversion or appropriation shall revert to the last authorized point of diversion or appropriation if the changes authorized under a transfer are not completed.

Findings of Fact

1. On July 3, 2006, Loren Leighton, for Weyerhaeuser Company, filed an application for an additional point of diversion under Certificate 20942. The Department assigned the application number T-10212.
2. On April 9, 2007, the Water Resources Department issued an order approving the proposed additional point of diversion. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 71, Pages 475-478.
3. On April 19, 2007, the Water Resources Department issued a superseding order correcting a scrivener's error in the original order. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 71, Pages 556-559. A second correcting order was issued May 8, 2007 and recorded in Special Order Volume 72, Pages 4-7.
4. On May 18, 2009, the Water Resources Department issued an assignment from Weyerhaeuser Company to International Paper Company.
5. On January 5, 2012, Loren Leighton, of International Paper, notified the Department that the additional point of diversion authorized under T-10212 would not be completed and



requested that the authorized points of diversion revert back to just the original point of diversion.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The points of diversion authorized under Application T-10212 are reverted to the point of appropriation authorized under the water right prior to the transfer. A superseding certificate for the right affected by the transfer shall be issued.
