ORDER


On October 28, 1981, T. N. and Nedine Barnhouse submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Grant County, entered November 16, 1956, in the Matter of Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of John Day River, tabulated in the name of George H. Hall at page 516, Volume 10, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 46388, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Mrs. Art Morgan, and is for the use of water from John Day River, with a date of priority of 1867, for irrigation of a certain 2.4 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 9, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 46388, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
