OF CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT)
OF DIVERSION OF WATER)

On September 28, 1984, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Ray Lakey for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Deschutes River and Its Tributaries, a water right was allowed in the name of Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company for use of the waters of Deschutes River for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 1.0 acre in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 16, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, WM, with a date of priority of September 1, 1899, being tabulated in the name of James Price in Volume 16, page 158, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 29054, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Swalley Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to a certain 1.0 acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, WM, and to change the point of diversion to a pump located 100 feet South and 50 feet East from the most Northerly Corner of Tax Lot 4100, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, WM.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company and the Board of Directors of said Company has approved the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion of water.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion of water are approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1986.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change of water right shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to Deschutes Reclamation and Irrigation Company confirming this and other changes within the District, and superseding Certificate 29054.
