On June 21, 1983, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert A. Dasch for approval of a change in place of use of water from Althouse Slough, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 3421, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Robert A. Dasch, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second from Althouse Slough, for irrigation of a certain 4.5 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 13, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM, with a date of priority of June 26, 1919.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 800 feet South and 200 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to another 4.5 acres in said NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 13, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM. The change in place of use is reported to be completed.

Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 3421, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
