3. Permit Amendment Application T-10769 proposes to move the authorized point of appropriation to two wells approximately 160 and 370 feet from the existing point of appropriation located:

14 S	10 E	WM	21	NW SE	Well 1 - 77 feet South and 1810 feet West from the E¼ Corner of Section 21
14 S	10 E	WM	21	SW NE	Well 2 - 159 feet North and 1625 feet West from the E¼ Corner of Section 21

4. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department’s weekly notice on February 3, 2009. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

**Permit Amendment Review Criteria**

5. The change would not result in injury to other water rights.
6. The change does not enlarge the permit.
7. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.

**Conclusions of Law**

The change in point of appropriation proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-10769 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

The change and subsequent use of water shall be subject to the following conditions:


1. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

2. Prior to water use from the proposed point of appropriation, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
4. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-15788 remain the same.
5. Permit G-15788, in the name of Willows Properties, an Oregon general partnership of James and Judith Knapp, is amended as described herein.
