ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN USE, PLACE OF USE,
AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 7262 submitted by

LARRY LINDSAY
c/o PORT OF MORROW
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BOARDMAN, OREGON 97818.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a portion of Certificate 64190, was perfected under Permit G-4918 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 3, 1970. The right allows the use of 3 WELLS, in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 62.7 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second, if available at the original wells; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 23, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 10, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 3, T 2 N, R 26 E, WM; WELL 62 - 3700 FEET SOUTH AND 1790 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 23; WELL 62A - 560 FEET NORTH AND 1450 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 10; WELL 62B - 3500 FEET NORTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.2 ACRE
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	32.8 ACRES
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	29.5 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.2 ACRE

SECTION 23

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be reduced.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the use and place of use of 0.67 cubic foot per second of water to INDUSTRIAL USE located:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

SECTION 31

TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The applicant also proposed to change the point of appropriation to:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 6, T 2 N, R 26 E, WM; 20 FEET SOUTH AND 317 FEET WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 6.


THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original points of appropriation.
3. The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

4. Water may be appropriated at any time during the year, provided the rate does not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second and the volume does not exceed 305.6 acre-feet in any year.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
6. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificate 64190 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
