O R D E R


On September 16, 1964, Paul Welters and Mayme A. King, coexecutors of the Estate of J. Rudolph Welter, submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain lands and the water right appurtenant thereto; that they have abandoned any and all interes' in and to said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second of water from Welter Creek, with a priority date of June 14, 1939, for domestic and stock purposes within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, W.M., and is evidenced by the certificate recorded at Volume 12, page 13529, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right".

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water right, evidenced by the certificate recorded at Volume 12, page 13529, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
