ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3188

On March 26, 1975, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Deschutes River Land and Cattle Company for approval of a change in place of use of water from Little Deschutes River (East Fork Deschutes River), pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 13639, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of M. S. Mayfield, describes a right which includes the use of water from East Fork Deschutes River for irrigation of 14.8 acres in NW¼ NE¼, 4.1 acres in SW¼ NE¼ and 10.1 acres in NW¼ SE¼ of Section 23, Township 23 South, Range 9 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1897.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the Walker Basin Canal, from a point located 260 feet North and 1060 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 34, being within the SW¼ SW¼ of Section 34, Township 23 South, Range 9 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 2.2 acres in NE¼ SE¼ and 26.8 acres in SE¼ SE¼ of Section 11, Township 23 South, Range 9 East, W.M.

Mr. Bruce Estes, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use of water is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. S. Mayfield and recorded at page 13639, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled; and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
